MINUTES BOARD OF DIRECTORS MARGARET CARDER LIBRARY Meeting on April 19, 2012

- 1. The meeting was called to order by Jane Clark with all five board members in attendance Paula Banister, Darlene Bock, Blake Bratton, Jane Clark and Brenda Scott. Martha Young, Librarian, was also present. A visitor, Janell Adams, was also in attendance.
- 2. The minutes of the January meeting were read. Darlene Bock moved to approve and Blake Bratton seconded. All voted to approve.
- 3. Martha Young gave the librarian's report and handed out the quarterly reports. She stated that she is checking on the possibility of providing e-books. This would probably require being part of a cooperative effort with other libraries and a grant.
